English

We continue to read and be inspired by high quality texts, these will include 'Iggy Peck, Architect' and 'Julian is a Mermaid'. We will continue to get the children ready for year 2, with a focus on phonics for reading and writing. We will be producing information leaflets and fantasy stories in writing.

We will also be doing the phonics screening in early June which will gauge how secure the children are at decoding words.

Maths

We will start by looking at fractions of shapes and numbers and the vocabulary whole, half and quarter. We will also learn about place value to 100 and prepare for transition.

Be Courageous, Be Curious

Science

We will learn about plants; how they grow and what they need to grow healthily. We will learn about deciduous and evergreen trees and go on a 'tree hunt' around school. We will be improving our investigation skills by taking part in some experiments.



RE

This half term we will be asking and answering 'big questions' about God. This will be through discussion and then we will move on to talk about how

Christians describe God.

Design Technology

We will be learning how to sew using child friendly needles. As part of our 600th Anniversary of St Ives Bridge week, we will be doing a range of cross-curricular activities including designing and making bridges.

Music

We will be learning to read, play (the syllables) and create picture notation using body percussion as well as tuned and untuned percussion instruments. We will also continue to learn the names of untuned instruments and learn music vocabulary. We will celebrate 'Make Music Day' too on 24th June!

Computing

This half term, we introduce learners to on-screen programming through ScratchJr. Learners will explore the way a project looks by investigating sprites and backgrounds. They will use programming blocks to use, modify, and create programs. Learners will also be

introduced to the early stages of program design through

the introduction of algorithms.

PSHE

We will be looking at our own wellbeing and how this is affected by change, including how we can better manage this as we prepare for our transition into year 2.

Geography

We will look at the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and their capital cities, this will include looking at important buildings in London and New York through our texts.
